**MASONIC WRITINGS**

**SAGITTA:**

The keystone of an arch. The abscissa of a curve.

**SADDUCEES:** (ZEDUKIM). A SECT CALLED FROM ITS FOUNDER Dadoc, who lived about 250 years B.C. They denied the resurrection, a future state, and the existence of angels. The Sadducees are often mentioned in the New Testament, the Talmud, and the Midrash. The tenets of the Sadducees are noticed as contrasted with those of the Pharisees. While Jesus condemned the Sadducees and the Pharisees, he is nowhere found criticizing the acts, words, or doctrine of the third sect of the Jews, the Essenes; wherefore, it has been strongly favored that Jesus was himself one of the last-named sect, who in many excellent qualities resembled Freemasons.

**SALUTEM:**

When the Romans wrote friendly letters, they prefixed the letter S as the initial of Salutem, or health, and thus the written expressed a wish for the health of his correspondent. At the head of Masonic documents we often find this initial letter thrice repeated, thus: s..s..s., with the same signification of Health, Health, Health. It is equivalent to the English expression "Thrice Greeting".
